ORDER

In order to motivate and encourage the schools towards maximum participation in extra curriculum activities, so as to promote all round development of students in Govt. Sector schools of Delhi, the Directorate of Education, after a careful consideration has taken following decisions in supersession to all previous orders;

1. All the funds under the nomenclature of Pupils' Fund, Scout/Guide Fund, SUPW Fund, Hobby Fund, Exam. Fund be clubbed together, which hereafter will be known as "Pupils' Welfare Fund". The revised rates will be as under;

S.No.	Class	Rates
(i)	Primary Classes (I to V)	Rs.10/- per child/month
(ii)	Middle Classes (VI to VIII)	Rs.15/- per child/month.
(iii)	Sec./Sr. Sec. Classes (IX to XII)	Rs.20/- per child/month
(iv)	SC/ST candidates (Class I to XII)	Rs.10/- per child/month

2. Besides, Pupils' Welfare Fund, Domestic Science Fund will be charged as usual.

3. Pupils' Welfare Fund will be meaningfully utilized by Pupils' Welfare Fund Advisory Committee, consisting of Head of school as Chairman, at least two teachers and two students nominated by HOS. One of the teachers nominated shall function as Secretary, responsible for maintaining minutes of meetings and all the relevant records. All the records shall be liable to inspection by the Director of Education or any authorized officer or by any officer from the office of Accountant General or Central Revenue.

4. The accounts will be maintained in a Nationalized Bank.


